How we use your data

The personal data you provided on this form will be used by St Anne's College to process your donation in accordance with our contractual and legal obligations, and to meet our legitimate interest of alumnae and supporter engagement, fundraising and stewardship. Who has access to your data

We will only do this in appropriate circumstances, for specified purposes, by secure means, using the minimum amount necessary, and with the relevant data sharing agreements in place. We do not and will not sell your data.

How long we keep your data

We consider our relationship with our donors, supporters and alumnae to be lifelong and we will retain most of your data indefinitely unless you request otherwise.

Your rights
