The Oxford academic year is divided into three terms and three vacations. Each term; Michaelmas, Hilary and Trinity consists of eight weeks of teaching.

- Extended Oxford Academic Year – September plus Michaelmas, Hilary and Trinity terms
- Fall Term – September plus Michaelmas

- Hilary AND Trinity Terms only

Hilary Term begins	Sunday 14 th January
Hilary Term ends	Saturday 9 th March

Trinity Term 2024

Visiting Students arrive back at College	Thursday 18 th April
Trinity Term begins	Sunday 21 st April
Trinity Term ends	Saturday 15 th June

Please note:

- Please ensure you plan to arrive on the arrival date listed above for the start of your programme. We cannot accommodate early arrivals. During the Visiting Students induction you will also meet with your Personal Tutor.
- Accommodation for visiting students is guaranteed and included during the breaks between terms when your studies are continuing through the next term. There is no additional charge for vacation residence.
- Travelling during term time is discouraged and you should expect to have academic requirements during the week, including Fridays. Please do not plan any travels during the weekdays of term, or during Freshers Week, you are expected to be at College and available for all academic and induction sessions.
- Please note that when returning from vacations (for Hilary and Trinity terms) all students including visiting students must be present in Oxford from midday on the Thursday preceding the start of each term, to allow for meetings with their Tutors and other College and University staff.
