1. President's Business

4. Any Other Business

 - Ellie → will speak with Krishh and the new committee about that. All other colleges who are offering the program are using our motion from previous weeks to also have a foundation year rep.

- Krishh → Next year's exec committee had an informal meeting. Brainstormed ideas for events, figuring out budget, talked about freshers week. We wanted to make some changes and were wondering how that could be done?
 - Ayesha → you don't have much choice about what the college plans on the college side. Have to get people to the talks regardless and then organise around that. Would be worth giving them feedback though if you had particular thoughts.
 - Ruby → Wanted to rework the consent workshop, it was difficult for people to leave, we want a separate welfare space.
 - Simon → We did have that last year but no one used it. Could sign people in to the welfare space instead so right from the start the don't have to go.
 - Ayesha → can have this conversation later at a meeting with fresher's week.
- Daniel → worries about accommodation in RSH being so expensive for next year?
 - Ayesha → it's also due to the fact that the contracts are longer. College hasn't really talked with us about exactly how long the contracts will be, but will check with them and get back to everyone.
