"In the last year over 60 Young Stanners have made one off or regular donations to our **Young Stanners Fund**. Gifts like these help support our valuable outreach programme, which is 100% funded by donations. Thank you. Your gifts in so many ways help support and inspire the students of the future.

Outreach matters. In a country where opportunity isn't evenly spread, it's the chance to open a door that might otherwise stay closed, and introduce Oxford to someone who never thought it could be a place for them. This year 24.8% of the pupils we've worked with receive free school meals and 55.5% live in the most disadvantaged areas in **the UK**. These are students who often have the fewest resources, the least support, and limited exposure to higher education. We show them that coming to Oxford University could change their future.

So far this year, we have run or been involved in 160 outreach events, reaching an estimated 5700 students, teachers and parents/carers, with 120 different schools across our link regions of Hillingdon and Southwark in London, the North East of England and beyond. Every Michaelmas, we speak to current students who say that without Outreach officers, they would never have found themselves at Oxford. Without the Outreach Fund, we couldn't make this happen. Donations to Outreach are what enable us to keep up the hard work to make sure St Anne's is the home of choice for the brightest students, no matter their background."
