You may also speak with your study abroad office about submitting an independent application. Your US home institution does not need to have a partnership with St Anne's College, Arcadia or IFSA for you to apply.

If you are applying from China you could consider applying through <u>UniHive Education</u>, the <u>Oxford Prospects Programme</u>, or you may consider applying as an independent applicant.

All applicants are required to have the permission of their home institution to apply and need to be studying towards an accredited degree. Postgraduate students can apply to the Visiting Students Programme but will follow Oxford's undergraduate curriculum.
