St Anne's College Nursery Fees 2025/26

St Anne's College Nursery offers subsidised places for children over 9 months.

Early Years Funding

Up to 30 hours free childcare may be available to children aged 9 months to 4 years, subject to eligibility.

All 3 year olds are automatically entitled to 15 hours free childcare.

The government funded scheme provides free childcare for 38 weeks of the year. St Anne's Nursery stretches this entitlement over the 47 weeks the nursery is open. Government funded only places are subject to availability and current occupancy levels.

For parents opting for a full-time place, the free hours are allocated as follows:

Funding begins from the start of the term following the date your child becomes eligible (1st September, 1st January, or 1st April).

If you are eligible for additional free childcare you will receive an eligibility code, please pass this code onto the nursery as soon as possible.

Fees September 2025 - August 2026

Full-time Charge £72.76 per day

Parents will be charged each month for all days the nursery is scheduled to be open. Refunds will not be issued for days of non-attendance, regardless of reason.

Fees include snacks and wipes.

Payment terms are 30 days from the invoice date.

Deposits

A deposit of £50 will be required to join the waiting list. This does not apply to parents applying for a funded only place.

On acceptance of a nursery place a deposit of £1,400 will be required to secure the place. The place will not be considered secured until payment has been received. The deposit will be refunded when your child takes up the reserved place, we will be in contact with you to discuss how your deposit will be refunded.

Late collection fees

A late collection fee of £10 will be charged for every 5 minutes after the scheduled pick-up time. This will be added to your next invoice.

Late payment charges

If you are unable to make the monthly payment on time, please discuss the matter with the Treasury by emailing invoices@st-annes.ox.ac.uk. Late payment can result in the application of a late payment fee of £25 per month. This amount will be added to your next invoice.

Optional charges

Parents will be asked to contribute to the costs of any optional excursions. Parents who do not wish to participate will not be charged.
