#### **Changing Gendered Welfare Requirements**

##### **Demi**

- Potential change - struggle for a few years to elect men's welfare - not many men want to do welfare
- Want to avoiding elections in the vac
- Daisy said if there were 4 women etc, it would immediately go to men - automatically giving role to men, rather than the person most qualified for a job
- They made it 3 for a reason - because of heavy workload

##### **Neve**

- Are people coming to the men? Are male welfare reps providing any help for men?

##### **Demi**

- Well with the requirement for men, we could also pose the question of "Do we need a black welfare, etc?"
- Men's welfare separately is important
- Men not as a minority - hesitant in regards to the optics

##### **Tully**

- If there was a way to get rid of the gender split - would it be two or three welfare reps

##### **Demi**

- Yes - still 3 reps, as it is so much work

| Sam                            | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Sees no structural issue with LGBTQ at the moment</li> <li>- Good just to have mens rep as a separate rep</li> </ul>  |
| Demi                           | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Should men be equal access committee ? They have privilege, and aren't classed as minority?</li> </ul>  |
| Neve                           | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Even the creation of a mens rep will require a change to the constitution so we have to take it through council and governing body</li> <li>- We have to look at pros and cons - write up arguments</li> </ul>  |
| Charlie                        | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Would men's budget come out of welfare budget, or will it need its own separate pot?</li> </ul>   |
| Demi                           | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Men's rep surely wouldn't need to spend anything</li> <li>- Maybe men's events not as needed as women's events</li> <li>- Role would mainly be fundraising</li> </ul>   |

- welfare reps, and any nominated member that would benefit
- 4 hours training on one day
  - Isabella, Maia, Ollie, Sienna, Sam - as the preliminary members of the JCR on the equal opportunities committee or dealing with minorities
  - Training would help with knowing where to signpost and listening effectively to serious issues

Affirmation from Sam and Laila - willing to do training

Maia

- I already have a qualification for mental health- can that count instead?

Demi

- Paid for by the college not the JCR, so it shouldn't be an inconvenience
- I can send the link to the shared doc if you'd like to look at what is involved

Tully

- Why has it not been done before?
- Is there a history of people going to ask for welfare support?

Demi

- If people just don't feel comfortable about things to do with race, homophobia etc, it's important that not just the welfare officers have training, as we might not fulfil those roles

Sam

- I've had lots of messages about trans issues etc

Demi

- Yes - Its not just about welfare, but also signposting, tools within university

Demi

- Is the budget definitely 3k not 2.7k?

Charlie

- The money is as sent to you by message
- Trying to keep a rainy day pot as well - so the whole budget is not currently distributed

Demi

- To Jack (IT officer) - constitution needs to be changed to show the spending on sexual health is part of the welfare levy and the role of the welfare reps

Bar Rep

Clarissa

- No application so far , but interest from Oisin and Rohan
- What does that involve constitutionally? Do we need to do anything formal to appoint them?

- We know that 3 positions are allowed in as part of the Entz committee, but we don't want a ticket or BOP rep, so all we really can justify is a bar rep?

Neve

- I can go to John but will need reasons why we would expand the Entz committee to two people for Bar rep
- Environment is two this year - we have already had a JCR expansion so we should try and limit it

Clarissa

- How long is the process for getting college approval for 2 reps?

Neve

- Should get done for week 6
- I could email John and we could get it done in a week or two
- But depends what is said and the justifications we give

Tully

- But what is the motivation for having 2 reps

Evelena

- We want to increase the role by liaising with the MCR, take on different responsibilities - e.g. music for Oisin, equipment in the bar

Neve

- We will definitely need a list of why and how the role would be expanded

Clarissa

- To update the constitutional role
  - We would add contact with the MCR about bar usage etc
  - Bar rep currently only working with Mike and Entz

Antonia

- Could you propose ticketing role

Clarissa

- Perhaps

Clarissa

- Neither of them have yet applied so this is all hypothetical
- Perhaps separate applications would be great

Evelena

- We'd like to buy new equipment, as we currently only have a sound system that can play CD's

Tully

- I will double check but consensus is I'm in full control of whatever is in the JCR office
- But want to check if the equipment is a JCR asset before we do anything concrete with it

- Evelena
- The MCR would probably like to rent but it could stay in the JCR office
- Clarissa
- We'd like to buy equipment , and keep it in the JCR office, BOPs, other people can use it
  - Reasonably expensive, so cannot be damaged
- Evelena
- John would be swayed with security measures
  - We shall keep it in **REDACTED**, locked away
- Charlie
- Do people know what they are allowed to spend or not allowed to spend money on in regards to Entz
- Evelena
- Mike said that there seems to be some kind of college approval needed
- Charlie
- I'll ask John then
  - Jenny was very much dubious about equipment
  - Post - 150 it has to be given to college for approval, shall we say
- Budget for Women's Rep
- Maia
- Womens rep was quite passive last year, so this year I've been more active and I've already organised a bar crawl
  - Is it possible to use any of the JCR budget for a bar tab - to get people to come?
- Neve
- Yes you only have £100, so not a lot
  - If it's under £75, and we have that money somewhere, EXEC can pass on that
- Charlie
- I assumed this was motion only
  - But this could stop money going to charities etc in JCR motions
  - But could come out of spare stuff from freshers that we have left over
- Clarissa
- Would the bar tab be for the college bar? Because £50 pounds in the college bar is a lot of drinks so maybe you wouldn't need much
- Maia
- Think the budget would probably be for a pub in Jericho
  - Other colleges are also proposing £50 each so it would be a cumulative effort

| Neve    | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- I think it's very relevant with the history of St Annes that we try and support feminist and women's soc activities as much as possible</li> </ul>  |

- If they have a point to bring they can come, but otherwise not necessary

### General Budget

Vikram

- When is the election for visiting students rep?

- It will be in the first half of michaelmas - anyone have a preference for merging freshers and foundation year rep?

- Also I have one event per term - I don't have enough money
